### **Write/Pair/Share**

Students process questions asked of them by writing their thoughts. Have attendees summarize what they're learning, to answer a question posed during the discussion, or to consider how and why and when they might apply a concept to their own situations. Works well with pre-planned questions and with ideas that emerge during a workshop from a larger group discussion. After writing down their thoughts each student turns to a partner to discuss. The objectives are to engage participants with the material on an individual level, in pairs, and finally as a large group. The activity can help to organize prior knowledge; brainstorm questions; or summarize, apply, or integrate new information. Students process the question asked of them by writing about it. The activity closes with the instructor calling on random students to summarize their responses. The instructor may choose to skip the summary portion of the exercise depending on circumstances.
