NOVAK EDUCATION WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION PART 1

Being "book-smart" or good at test-taking are rarely the best markers of success. Our students must know how to collaborate, communicate, problem-solve and think critically to thrive in the workplace. When learners are self-aware and able to identify and regulate their emotions, and when they can work well independently or with peers, they can tap into parts of their brain that may otherwise be shut off to learning. In a nutshell, all learning is social and emotional. Throughout this session, we will explore how to create an environment that fosters social, emotional, behavioural, and academic growth using both UDL and SEL in your learning environment.
